	Variety	Dril	Sow	Cover
	<p>Game Maize: gives excellent cover during summer, autumn and winter with good feed value from cobs. Supplied as a Single variety or as a Blend of several varieties to give prolonged cover and feed.</p>	acre packs	May-June	Aug-Feb
	<p>Millet: Provides cover similar to pheasants natural environment. Often sown with sunflower and/or sorghum. Can be used in feeding blocks or as flushing points</p> <p>White/ Red millet: White has better standing ability whilst Red millet produces more seed.</p> <p>Reed Millet: Tanka provides excellent cover, good standing with winter-hardiness Sown alongside maize for added protection. Better suited to wetter soils.</p> <p>Millet blends:red/white/reed millets blended to give a longer period of seed release. Also available blended with Quinoa</p>	5kg/acre acre packs	May-June	Aug-Jan
	<p>Sorghum: Used as shelter belts around maize and for flushing. Drought resistant. Avoid poorly drained soils and areas of high weed infestation.</p> <p>Giant Sorghum: up to 2.5 metres gives good cover during winter. Tall stems encourage bird to lift above cover.</p> <p>Intermediate Sorghum: Height 1.5-2.0 metres Useful windbreak and gives good protection against predators. Good seed production.</p> <p>Dwarf Sorghum: up to 1.5 metres tall. Dense cover providing warm holding for birds. Ideal driving crop. Good standing and large seed heads.</p>	acre packs	May-June	Aug-Jan
	<p>Quinoa: provides useful feed for holding pheasants and partridges. Also attracts seed eating smaller birds. Usually sown with kale.</p> <p>Quinoa/Kale: give excellent cover and protein rich food for game and smaller birds.ready mixed and treated.</p>	1/2 acre packs 1 acre packs	May-June	Sep-Jan
